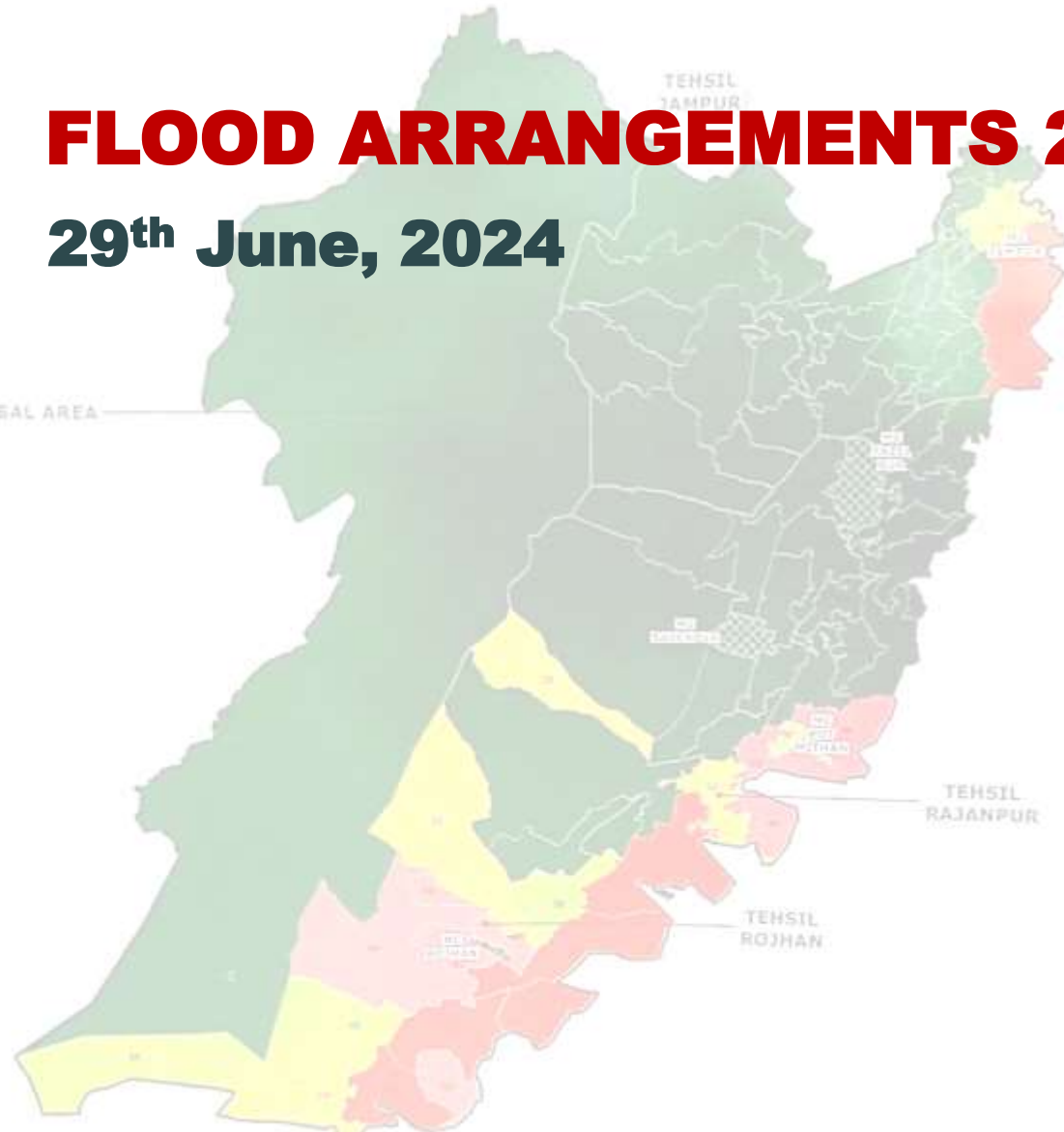

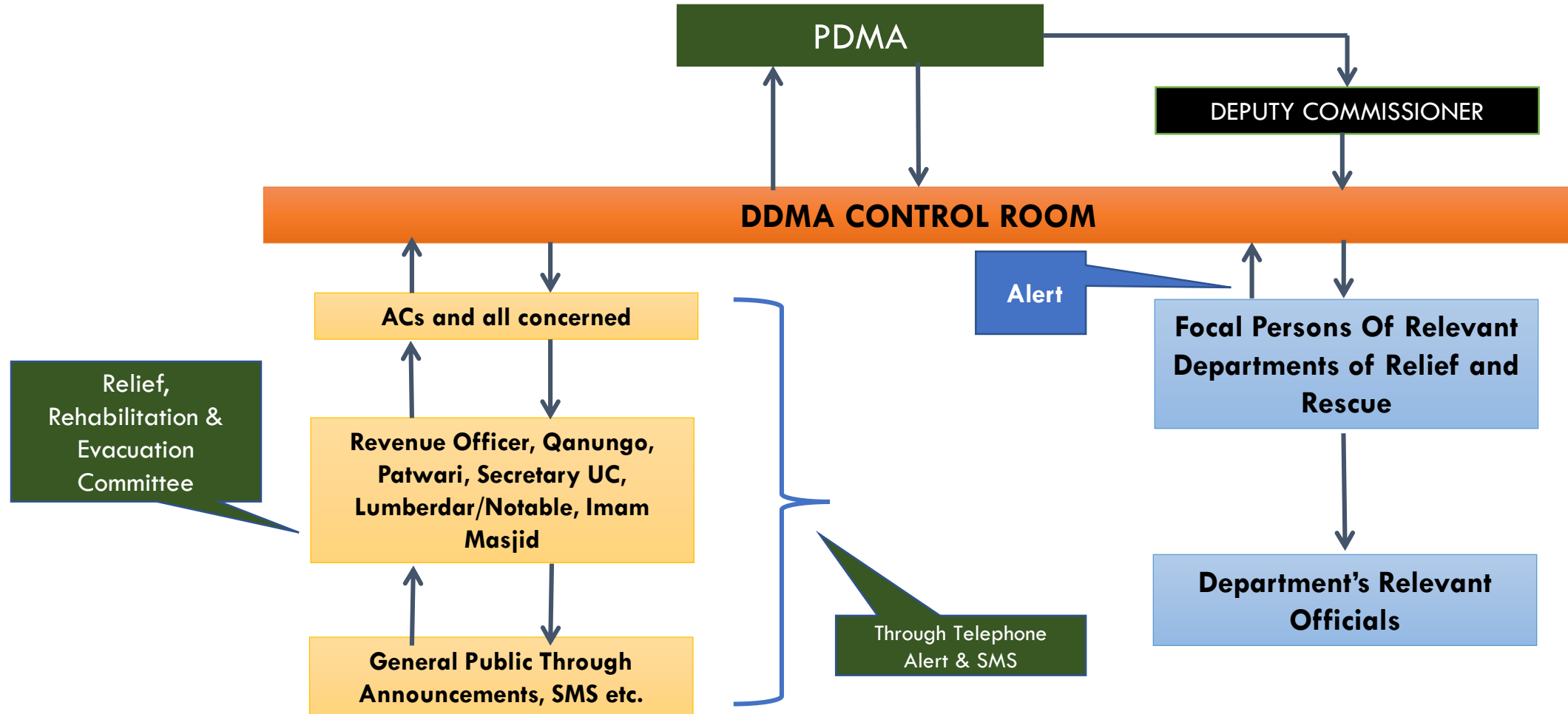


EARLY WARNING & EVACUATION PLAN

- The District Emergency Control Room is connected with PDMA Control Room.





EARLY WARNING & EVACUATION PLAN

- **Mauza wise Early Warning Response & Rehabilitation Committees have been notified.**
- **Revenue field staff will ensure their presence to assist and coordinate with flood Affectees.**
- **Rep. from Irrigation Department will also be present at vulnerable areas to keep an eye on flood situation.**
- **Health Camps shall be established.**
- **Livestock staff will establish their camps and mobile dispensaries to handle emergencies.**
- **Police will ensure security of flood Affectees and to maintain law and order.**
- **Food and shelters / camps shall be provided.**
- **Evacuation of flood affectees will be ensured by Rescue 1122.**
- **Pak Army will be called in case of emergency.**

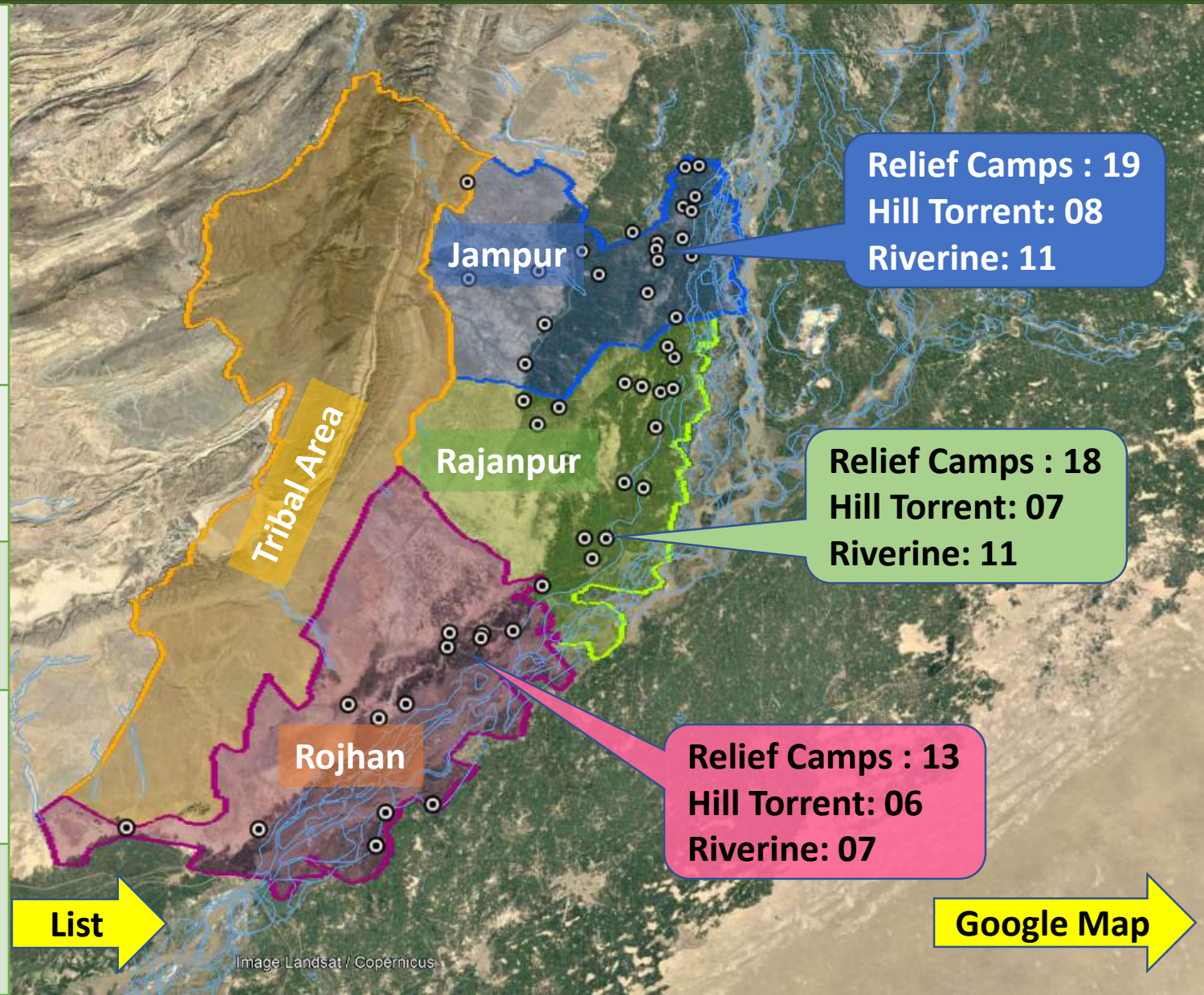

LESSON LEARNT

- **Breach / cut committee has been notified at tehsil level in order to timely discharge the flood water through existing route and to avoid un-necessary pondage of flood water.**
- **Comprehensive Deployment plan of Rescue and Relief has been prepared.**
- **Vulnerable areas (fully and partially affected) has been Geo tagged on google map.**
- **Water from Hill Torrents need to be channelized and streamlined by introducing and implementing proper Water-shed Management Techniques and comprehensive policy for flood mitigation and control mechanism.**





POTENTIAL THREATS OF HILL TORRENTS / RIVER INDUS OR CHENAB



POTENTIAL THREATS / WAY FORWARD

- **Kachhi Canal is totally choked / silted up from RD: 752 to 761. Due to this reason flood water of upstream side of hill torrents i.e. Chachar, Pitok and Zangi Hill Torrent accumulated along the Musharaf Flood Bund. Moreover, the said bund will remain under threat due to non closing of left and right side of breaches in Kachhi Canal.**
- **Design capacity of flood carrying channels (FCCs) emerging from Dajal branch is half than the design capacities of syphons of Dajal branch. To discharge the flood water of Kaha & Chhachhar, it is necessary that all FCCs must be constructed at full capacity of syphon of Dajal branch.**



POTENTIAL THREATS / WAY FORWARD

- To address socio political issues, project of Qutub drain has been stopped. It is suggested that a new drain namely “Murghai Drain” may be constructed to curtail long section of Qutub Drain.
- Currently Musharaf Flood Bund & Drain are under direct hit of flood water of Kachhi Canal. It is strongly recommended that Musharaf Drain may be extended upto Indus River for safe dispose of flood water.
- Building of Small Dams / Reservoirs in Hill Torrents areas.
- Provision of new Bridges / Culverts all along the Indus Highway for the safe passage of water.
- Development of Pond Areas for irrigation and drinking purpose.

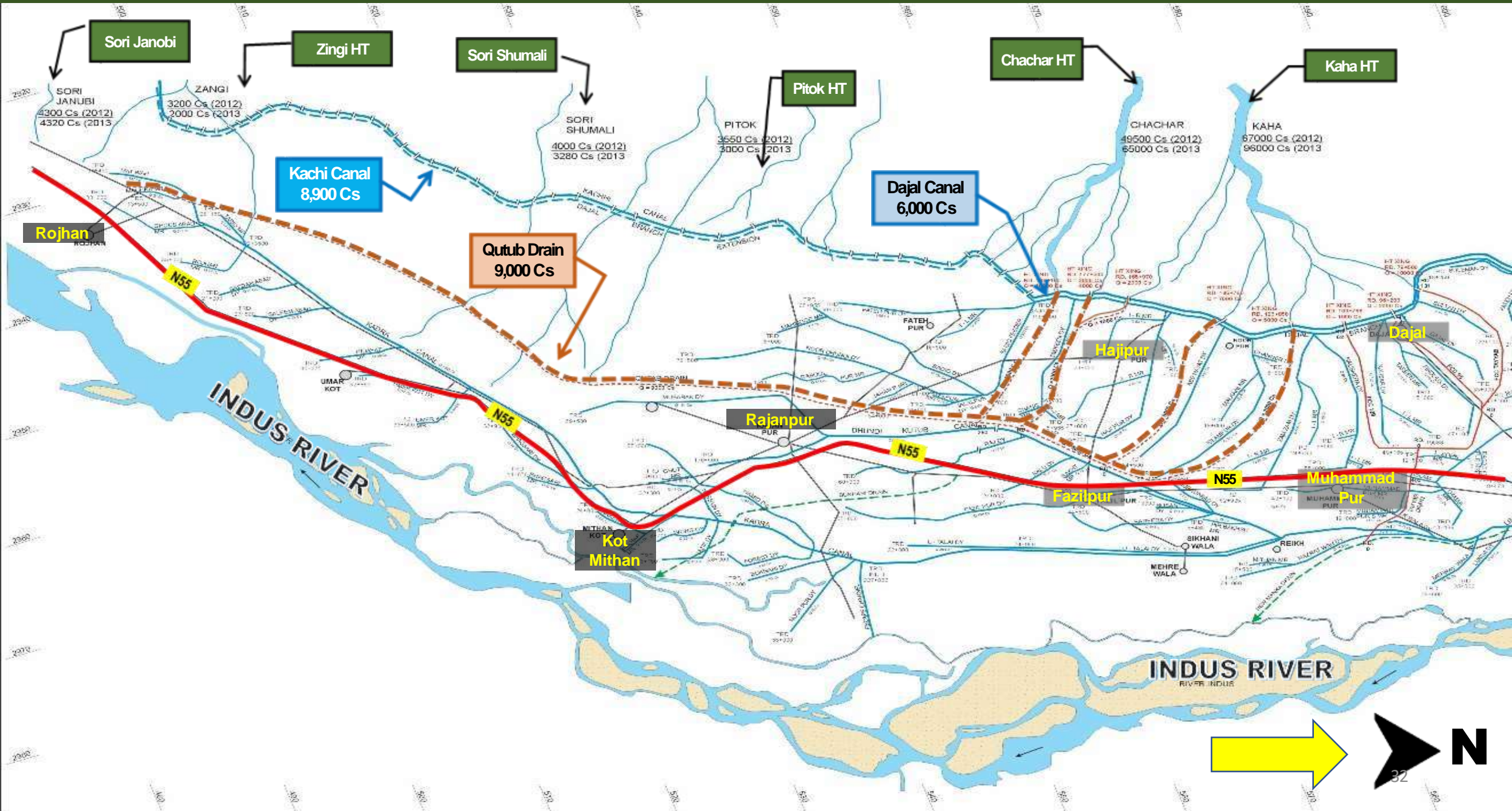

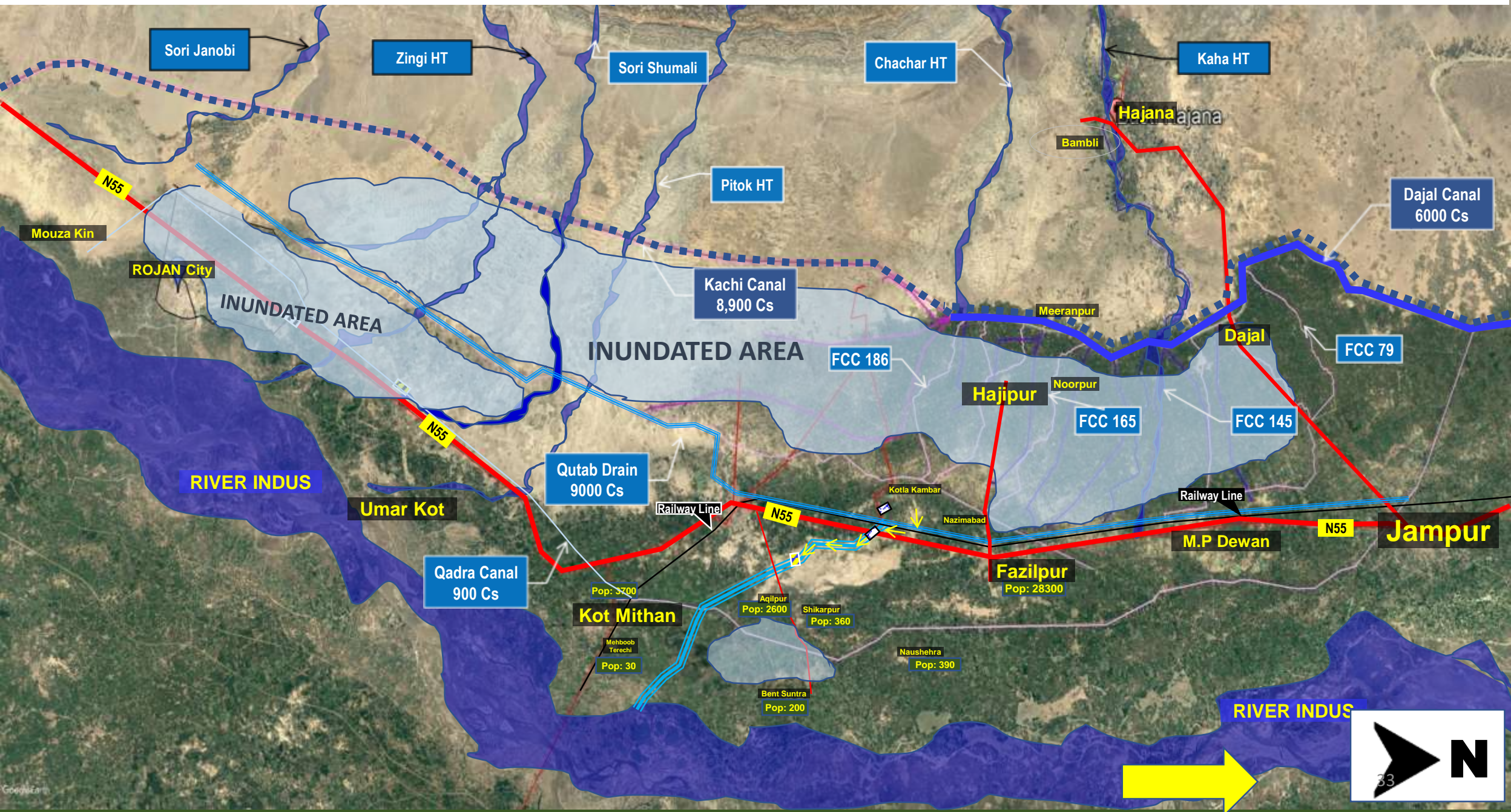

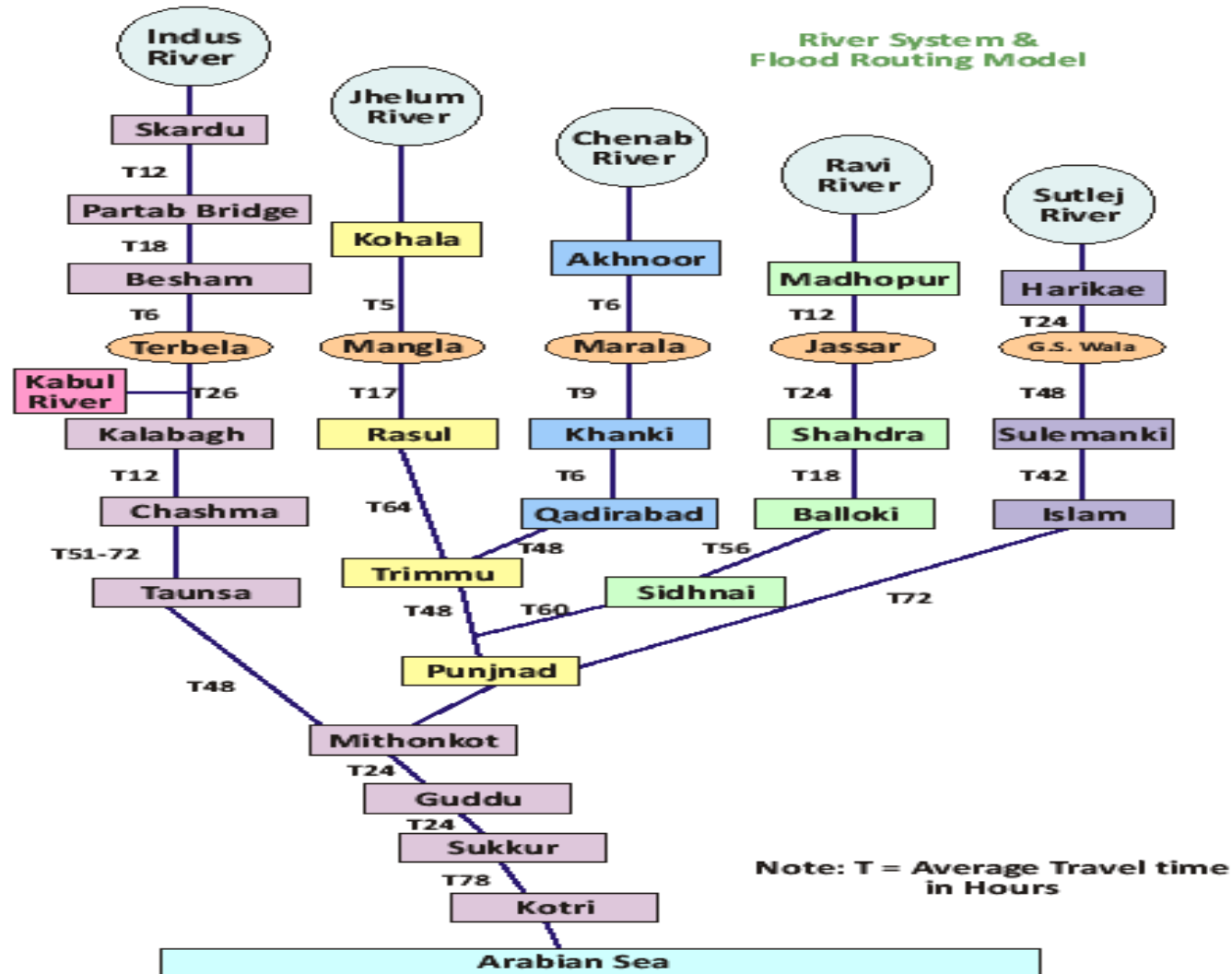
